Exploring Photography Policies and Procedures

FOOD & DRINK POLICY

In general, food and drinks are **NOT** allowed in class. However, you may bring water bottle as long as it can be sealed and is kept away from technology/electronics.

Camera Rules

- Always wear the camera strap.
- When using a camera, you must check it OUT/IN.
- Only school-appropriate photographs are allowed to be taken.
- Do not touch the lens with your fingers or your shirt.
- If the lens needs to be cleaned, inform the teacher.
- Always be CAREFUL. (No running to get the perfect shot!)
- When finished with the camera it is your responsibility to return it to the charging area after checking it IN.
- Do not let ANYONE use the camera. Only students in Photography have permission to use the camera. If you are caught doing so, you will lose camera privileges.
- Cameras do NOT leave school unless instructed to do so.
- Remember to power the camera OFF when finished.
- Be careful removing the memory card.
- Upload all images to Google.
- Be cautious of the photos you take. Take them with a purpose in mind.
- Use the camera to create art and long-lasting memories!

ABSENCES AND GRADES

Please check Google Classroom for daily classwork and assignments. Grades are updated weekly. All photo assignments are turned in on Google Classroom.

If you are absent, you are responsible for completing your make-up work (three days for make-up for each day absent).

If you need a camera to make up a photo assignments, please see me to arrange a time before or after school to complete the assignment. Make-up Adobe Photoshop assignments can be completed in Homework Club.

If you know you are going to be absent beforehand, you should ask me for your make-up work before the absence.
