Course Content/Goals

This one year course provides instruction in Pre-Algebra concepts as identified by the Common Core State Standards. This course is designed to build on knowledge and skills through re-teaching math concepts, extra practice and time to master a skills, guided and independent practice to gain a better understanding, and whole group discussion of concepts. Instructional practices incorporate diversity and individual student needs in order to gain a better understanding of Pre-Algebra concepts for mastery.
