 - In past positions were funded at 36:1, we try to do 33:1 (save money with librarian, counselors)
 - Proposing to save money by cutting a few positions, do to new school coming 2021-2022 which will impact teacher positions
 - Cuts will come from 6th ELA, 7th ELA, 7th Science (retirement), 7th/8th Social Studies (leave of absence), Campus Monitor (with new SSPF jobs, this position is not needed). Class sizes will be around 35:1 for 2020-2021. Focusing on what may happen for 2021-2022 with rezoning and new middle school. Doesn't want to leave this up to surplus or seniority.
