Elections will be held online September 21, 2022 through a Google Form



As part of the reorganization of the Clark County School District, our school will form a School Organizational Team (SOT) that includes teachers, support staff, parents/guardians, and one student. The student member will be elected by a vote of all TMS students. Including the voice of our students is important to the success of our school.

What is the role of the School Organizational Team?

- Provide input on the school performance plan and budget.
- Provide continued advice to the principal in carrying out the school plan.
- Assist with the selection of the next principal when there is a vacancy.

What are the requirements of Team members?

- Begin attending training and meetings in October 2022.
- Serve on the team through September 2023, unless you no longer attend the school.
- Attend meetings at least once per month, outside of school hours.
- Make decisions with the whole school population in mind.
- Work collaboratively and attempt to reach consensus with the team.

Vote for the Best Candidate



Elections will take place through a Google Form that will be posted as an announcement on your CANVAS Homepage. The student with the most votes, regardless of their grade level, will be selected to serve on the SOT. If they decline, we will move to the student with the next highest vote total. Ties will be decided by random drawings.

Attend Monthly Meetings



The student who is selected through the voting process will be expected to attend monthly SOT meetings that will typically take place after school from about 3:30—4:30 PM. Meetings for the 22-23 year will be held virtually through Google Meet.

SOT members who are not employees of the Clark County School District will not be defended by the District if a lawsuit is filed against you because of what you say or do while participating as part of the school organizational team.
