

**Tarkanian Middle School**  
Afterschool/Extracurricular Activities  
Attendance Policy and Application

In order to maintain safety and an academic focus on campus, the following policy will remain in place for the 2021-2022 school year. Please note there is an attendance requirement for the remainder of the school year.

**Behavior**

If a student has been directly involved in any of the following behavior incidents for the 2021-22 school year, they will not be able to attend any after school extracurricular activities (festivals, sporting events, field trips, etc.) on campus or off-campus:

**Grades, Citizenship and Attendance**

If a student has any of the following for the 2021-2022 school year:

- Any Fs on progress reports or report cards
- Citizenship (Most recent marking period) - Unsatisfactory (U), Needs Improvement (N)
- More than 10 unapproved (UNV) absences

**Attendance Application**

If a student would like to attend or participate in any upcoming afterschool/extracurricular activities or events, a [TMS Extracurricular Afterschool Activity Attendance Application](#) must be completed using the student's Google account. You must complete this application, even if you have completed one prior to the Harvest Festival.

**Eligible**

Once you are approved to attend based on the above criteria, then you will be notified that you are eligible to attend each event (basketball, dances, field trips) via school email.

**Ineligible/Appeal Process**

If a student is ineligible to attend, they will be notified via school email prior to the event. The decision may be reconsidered by the administrative team by completing the attendance application and the following:

Write one essay (1 page, typed, 12 pt font). Use Google Doc to answer the following questions:

1. What has caused you to not be eligible for attending or participating in an event or activity?
2. What was the consequence of the infraction, failing grade, or citizenship?
3. What did you learn from this experience?
4. What could you do differently next time to prevent an infraction, failing grade, or citizenship?

**Appeal Submission and Review Process**

Submit the essay by email to David Copenbarger, Assistant Principal (copendm@nv.ccsd.net). Please include in the subject line: Afterschool/Extracurricular Activity Essay. Once the essay has been received and reviewed, an administrator will schedule a meeting with you to discuss attending the event

**Basketball Games**

Students eligible to attend basketball games at Tarkanian MS will be required to complete the extracurricular/after school activity application. Once approved, you will receive an email that you are eligible to attend for each game.
